Chronic pain roundtables scheduled in Bridgeport and Kingwood

The Central Appalachia Inter-Professional Pain Education Collaborative (CAIPEC) has scheduled additional roundtable events intended to facilitate chronic pain management case-based interactive sessions, highlighting educational content aligned with the seven CAIPEC module objectives. CAIPEC is a West Virginia Practice-Based Research Network project with the University of Kentucky. Several inter-professional community roundtable events have been held in collaboration with the regional Area Health Education Centers.

The goal is to improve the delivery of chronic pain management to Central Appalachia residents through an evidence-based and inter-professional approach as well as identify local factors either facilitate or impede patient care management.
