

CITI Research Ethics Training

The CITI Ethics training gives an overview of historical research events, To Do's, and What Not To Do. You will receive a certificate at the end of the training.



Each research investigator on a WVU protocol must take research ethics training before they are officially added to the protocol.

This includes Clinicians, Residents, Fellows, Students, and Staff who are assisting with the project.

- Create an account and register for the courses (no \$)
- Go to the “Human Subjects Research” course
 - Choose either Biomedical OR Social & Behavioral versions
- Once completed, keep the certificate for your files
- You do not need to send a copy to the WVU IRB Office. They will be notified directly by the CITI Program.
